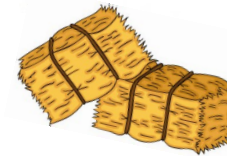
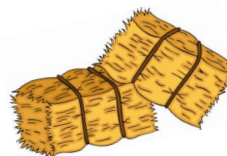

AG DAY IS ON... RAIN, HAIL OR SHINE!

Buses: NO buses will be running on Ag Day and school will be open from 8.30am.

Parking: Calf vehicle and trailer parking ONLY is available by the calf ring in the corner of the field by the long jump pit. Access is from behind Room 4 and the playground. Please be careful of the dog ring. Everyone else to park in the school car park please.

M. bovis: Due to M. bovis all calves need to be kept in their family bubbles. Please keep your calves tied to/in your calf trailer. Stewards will collect you and your calf for judging. Please don't let your calf sniff or touch other calves that aren't in your family bubble.

On Arrival: As children arrive with their animals they need to report to the table in front of the hall to have their number written on their hand.

Late Registrations: Late pet registrations can be made between 9.00am-9.45am on the deck in front of the hall. Judging will begin at 10.00am sharp! Ensure your animal has shade and water.

Pre-school Entries: Sand saucers will be displayed on the stage in the hall, with pets either inside or outside the hall. These entries are not judged—it is all about participation and having fun!

Pet Areas: All pets are to be secured in their areas unless waiting to be judged.

- **Calves** Due to M. bovis all calves need to be kept in their family bubbles. Please keep your calves tied to/in your calf trailer. Stewards will collect you and your calf for judging. Please don't let your calf sniff or touch other calves that aren't in your family bubble.
- **Lambs & Goats** to be tied to standards on the bank under the trees
- **Dogs** tied on wire under the trees on far side of the field
- **Other Pets** inside or in front of the hall

Garden Art Display: This will be set up and displayed around the Golden Elm Tree by Room 5

Classroom Exhibits: At the conclusion of judging (approx 11am), classrooms will be open for parents and children to look at the displays. Children are asked not to take exhibits from classes until people have had an opportunity to view.

No dangerous breeds i.e pit bull. Dogs must be socialised and used to being away from home/farm. **All dogs must be on a lead and tied up when not in the judging ring.** Dogs are to be 6 months or older. If your dog is under 6 months old, it will be entered in the 'Other Pets' section. All dogs must have a current registration and vet passport, produced at registration. Dogs should be wormed within three weeks of Ag Day. All children entering a dog or puppy will be given a "doggy do" bag—these bags must be used to clean up after your dog.
