From the Principal's Desk

Kia ora Koutou,

Greetings to parents and members of the Marotiri School Community,

We have begun the school year under the Red Traffic Light system with all the guidelines that brings with it. As mentioned previously, within every school community, we have the full range of views on masks, mandates, vaccines, and other requirements at each alert level. However, I feel proud of our school community who have worked with us to allow the staff and Board to focus on maintaining the safety of all students while continuing to provide an innovative learning programme

As principal and Board, our leadership decisions must be based on direction from the experts in this field. Our responsibility is to enact required procedures and mandates from the Ministry of Health and Education as best as possible to cater for all. Unfortunately, this does mean that some planned events are unable to go ahead, or need to be modified to mitigate any risk to our students. While we have included the list of scheduled events in our 'What's on this term', please note that we will only take part in events that involve other schools or regions if we are under the Orange Traffic Light system. At this stage, we will not be participating in the Pinelands swimming events for that reason.

Please let your child's teacher and office know immediately if your family is in any way affected by COVID. If a positive case is confirmed at Marotiri School, we will carefully follow Ministry of Health Guidelines, and it will depend on the nature of the case as to whether groups of students and staff isolate, or we continue business as usual. The school will only shut under advice by Ministry of Health & Education. Our school community will be kept informed.

Our Term one inquiry focus is entitled 'Ngā Huanga - Marotiri as an Enviro School'. We will be working with students to inquire into what it means to be an Enviro School, and explore ways in which we can change and enhance our environment.

Our school wide goal is to Look after Ourselves and relate skilfully to others, a most important life skill to learn during these uncertain times.


